The COVID-19 pandemic is impacting the nation's programs for youth development, education, and workforce development, including those in the food and agricultural sciences. Formal and non-formal education activities are in high demand as Americans continue social distancing to keep COVID-19 infection rates under control. The need for these programs is particularly prevalent in rural areas.

The Agriculture and Food Research Initiative (AFRI) Education and Workforce Development RFA now includes a new program area priority to address the need to develop and deploy rapid, reliable, and readily-adoptable strategies in workforce preparation through formal K-14 education, as well as in youth development through non-formal education to cultivate interest and competencies in STEM and agriculture during this challenging time. Funded projects are expected to develop tools, techniques, and other practices that can be rapidly adopted at home or by educators and extension specialists to ensure the effective formal and non-formal education of K-14 students and other youth development opportunities.

This program area accepts new applications only. Applications will undergo an expedited peer-review and awarding process to ensure rapid project start-up.
