Do you need to meet National Science Foundation (NSF) or National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA) requirements for RCR or want to ensure a strong foundation for your research career? Join the [in-person](#) RCR Workshop at UTIA for an overview of RCR topics, such as research conflicts of interest, authorship practices, research data, and more. Also, the Division of Research Integrity and Assurance will discuss how we can support you in meeting your research integrity goals. This pertains to all personnel who have any part of their position funded on federal research grants and anyone else who participates on the projects should attend.

RCR Training Requirement: All participants on NIFA research projects, including Hatch projects, are required to have RCR training. NSF currently requires training of students and postdocs, and beginning 7/31/23, NSF will also require PIs and other senior personnel to have RCR
